#### Phi Beta Kappa Membership Fee

The initiation fee for the Columbia section of Phi Beta Kappa is **\$55**, payable before initiation. There are no annual dues after this payment. The fee entitles you to a Phi Beta Kappa handbook, an engrossed certificate, and a lifetime subscription to *Key Reporter*. This fee goes to the national PBK organization for your membership and registration.

#### Phi Beta Kappa Registration

In order to complete your initiation to Phi Beta Kappa, you must register with the national chapter headquarters.

Online Member Registration Instructions for New Phi Beta Kappa Members:

- 1. Go to <u>http://www.pbk.org/membership</u> and click to register.
- 2. Enter the passcode CCDelta.
- 3. Complete the blanks with your information. Make sure to select the proper chapter (school) of induction, and give the best email address to reach you.
- 4. Click *Preview* to view your information. If you need to make any changes, click *Back*
- 5. Choose *Next* to go on to the next step.
- 6. Now you may choose to either pay your membership fee online, or pay your chapter officer in person. Please keep in mind you are not considered an official member until dues have been paid.
- 7. If you choose *Yes* to pay your fee with a credit card, fill in your information and click *Ok*. There will be a confirmation and receipt to verify your payment.
- 8. Once online registration is complete, you will receive an email confirming that you have paid or indicating the amount owed. You will not be an official member until the chapter officer has validated your membership registration.
